Philips X2/MP2/X3/MX100/MP5 Roll Stand



Tools Required: Phillips screwdriver (not provided), 1/2" [13mm] wrench (not provided).


Assembling the Roll Stand

- 1. Insert bottom end of Post in center of Base and lay assembly on its side for access to bottom of base (not shown).
- 2. Using a 1/2" [13mm] wrench, fasten Post to Base with one (1) 5/16-18 x 1" HHCS, with 5/16 split lock washer, and 5/16" flat washer as shown below. Return Roll Stand to upright position.




Attaching Utility Basket and Handle to Roll Stand Post

- 1. Attach two (2) Basket Clips to Utility Basket as shown below left. Insert two (2) #8-32 x 7/8" PHMS and #8-32 hex nuts in Basket Clips but do not tighten.
- 2. Slide Basket Clips over top end of Roll Stand Post (below right) and move Basket to mounting position. Do not tighten screws at this time. Basket may require re-alignment after the Fixed Tilt Mount is attached.




3. Position the Handle below the top of the Roll Stand Post opposite the Basket. Fasten Handle to Post with two (2) #10-32 x 9/16" PHMS as shown, but do not tighten at this time. Handle may require re-alignment after the Fixed Tilt Mount is attached.




Attaching Fixed Tilt Mount to Roll Stand Post

1. Align three (3) mounting holes in Fixed Tilt Mount with corresponding mounting holes in top of Post and fasten Mount to Post with three (3) #10 x 3/4" FHMS as shown below. **Installation Note:** Fixed Tilt Mount must be oriented toward the intended front of the roll stand as shown below.



2. Remove backing from Lexan Screw Cover and place on top of screw heads as shown below. Procedure is same for X3/MP2 Mount (shown) or MP5 Mount.




3. Not shown. Align Basket and Handle with the Fixed Tilt Mount orientation and tighten mounting screws as required to secure Basket and Handle on the Post.

Mounting MP5 on the Roll Stand

The MP5 monitor will be equipped with one of two different mounting interfaces on the bottom of the monitor. The type of interface determines which mounting procedure to follow on this page.

Mounting MP5 on Philips Table Mount (Requires Philips-supplied Table Mount)


1. Fasten the Philips-supplied table mount to the Mounting Adapter with three (3) M6 x 10mm FHMS as shown below. Mount the monitor in accordance with Philips mounting instructions.





Mounting MP5 with Fixed Tilt Mount

1. Using a Phillips screwdriver, fasten monitor to Fixed Tilt Mount with two (2) M6 x 8 mm PHMS as shown.



Mounting X2/MP2/X3/MX100

Attaching IntelliVue Dock (supplied by Philips) to Fixed Tilt Mount

1. Fasten IntelliVue Dock to the Fixed Tilt Mount with two (2) M4 x 10 mm PHMS as shown below. Mount monitor on IntelliVue Dock according to manufacturer's instructions.



Attaching Mounting Plate (supplied by Philips) to Fixed Tilt Mount


1. Fasten mounting plate to the Fixed Tilt Mount with two (2) M4 x 14 mm PHMS as shown below. Mount monitor on mounting plate according to manufacturer's instructions.




Mounting the Power Supply

Installation Note: If using the IntelliVue Dock, no power supply is required.

1. Fasten Clamping Block to power supply with two (2) M4 x 12 mm PHMS as shown below.



2. Fasten power supply to Post with rear Clamping Block and two (2) #10-32 x 9/16" PHMS as shown below.



Mounting the Tympanic Thermometer Base Station

Installation Note: Install and route Base Station cables prior to fastening Clamping Block to Base Station.




Front Clamping Block




Back Clamping Block

1. Using a Phillips screwdriver, fasten the front Clamping Block to Base Station with two (2) M4 x 12 mm PHMS as shown below.





2. Using a Phillips screwdriver, secure the Base Station mounting assembly to post with the back Clamping Block and two (2) 10-32 x 9/16" PHMS as shown below.



Cable Management

Two (2) Cable Clips are provided for managing cables along Roll Stand Post. Place loose cables inside Clip and slide Clip onto Post as shown.





Routine Maintenance

Periodically check all mounting hardware. Tighten as necessary for optimal operation and safety.

Cleaning the Mounting Assembly

- 3. Do not use steel wool or other abrasive material to clean the mounting assembly.
- Damage caused by the use of unapproved substances or processes will not be covered by warranty. We
 recommended that you test any cleaning solution on a small area of the mounting assembly that is not visible to verify
 compatibility.
- 5. Never submerge or allow liquids to enter the mounting assembly. Wipe any cleaning agents off the mounting assembly immediately, using a water-dampened cloth. Dry all mounting assemblies thoroughly after cleaning.
